

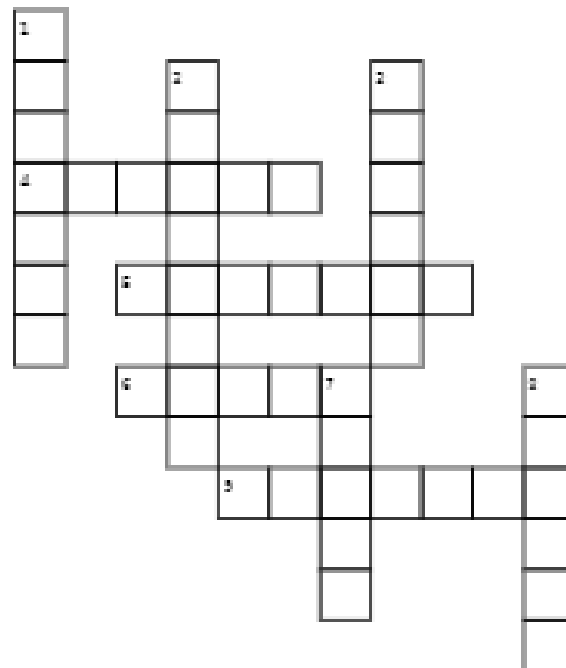
Suffixes Galore!
